### **Snowmobile Reminders**

If you are an owner/operator of a snowmobile there is an Ordinance within City limits to abide by. Snowmobiles shall only be operated on streets that have not been plowed with the exceptions of direct crossings of a prohibited street. Snowmobiles shall not be operated on an operating railroad right-of-way. Snowmobiles are not allowed in any park, playground or upon any other City-owned property without the express permission of the City. Be courteous of public property and do not operate upon the public sidewalks. There is a designated route through town running from the city shop, across B-15, on College to Main. From Main St to Broad and North on Broad out of town. Please stay on this path while traveling through Plymouth. You may get a copy of the designated route at City Hall.
