Plymouth City Council Meeting Proceedings Thursday, February 1, 2024

The Plymouth Council met in regular session on Thursday February 1st, at 7:00pm.

Mayor Berding called the meeting to order with the following members present- Lissa Merfeld, Jay Stump, Neal Brennan, Wade Eastman & Allan Rye.
