Spring is upon us!!

With spring upon us a friendly reminder about upkeep of yards, open burning and building permits.

Now that the snow has melted and grass and weeds will start growing, grass and weeds are to be cut periodically and should never be greater than eight (8) inches.

Open burning is allowed within the city limits. When burning within city limits it must be conducted in compliance with rules and limitations established by the State Department of Natural Resources.

Building permits are required for any structure being built, brought in, or added to within the City of Plymouth. Contact Ric Vermedal for building permits and applications.

There was a great turn out for the Annual Easter Egg Hunt on April 4th. There was over 40 kids that came out to see the Easter Bunny and hunt for some eggs. It has been decided with the great turn out from last year to this year that there is the need for *double* the amount of eggs for next year.
