The 2016 Plymouth City Dog Tags are being sold at the Plymouth City Hall on **Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday from 9a.m. – 5p.m., Thursday from 7 a.m. – 3 p.m.**

The fee for dog tags purchased during April is \$5.00 per tag, with a \$2.00 per month delinquent penalty will be charged on all tags purchased **after January 31st, 2016.** **There is a list of residents that have not purchased tags at the City Hall.**

GOLF CARTS

Plymouth passed a Golf Cart Ordinance No. 127, Dec. 3, 2015. You may see full ordinance at City Hall. Briefly it states, This must be followed by paying for Permits at City Hall that will be put on your cart, and by having your golf cart inspected for all equipment guidelines. Proof of Insurance specific for the cart, Slow moving vehicle sign, Safety Bicycle flag 5 ft from ground level, Valid Iowa operator's license, **16 yrs old and older only**. They are prohibited on Broad street and State highway. Operation is only from sunrise to sunset March 1 thru November 15, 2016. All traffic rules and regulations must be obeyed. Violators will be fined.
