GOLF CARTS

In 2015 Plymouth passed a Golf Cart Ordinance No. 127. Each cart needs a 2017 permit, \$25.00 per permit paid at City Hall, that will be put on your cart, and to have your golf cart inspected for all equipment guidelines. Proof of Insurance specific for the cart, slow moving vehicle sign, safety bicycle flag 5ft from ground level, and a valid Iowa operator's license, *16 years and older only.*

They are prohibited on Broad St and State highway. Operation is only from sunrise to sunset March 1—November 15. All traffic rules and regulations must be obeyed. Violators will be fined.
