Please note as of July 11, 2016 please only make your water deposits of your water bill payments at the City Hall Office/Drop Box instead of the FBS Bank drop box. This is to insure that your payment gets posted on your utility account asap and our system is current.

*** * ACH WATER BILL AUTOMATIC BANK * ***

This is only to those that have their payments done by ACH. Due to recently found error with a bank bad withdrawal file for April, the April payment was not withdrawn from your accounts. This will be taken out in June. This is a bill you already received and should have already planned on it being subtracted. There was also a computer glitch with ACH on the July 4th weekend with the file saying it was trying to withdraw on a holiday, which it wasn't, it was July 5th. Because of this, you will see it as a withdraw on July 11. We are hoping these will be the only time this happens now that the bank and I are aware of the problem. Thank you for your understanding
