

2014 City Dog Tags

The 2014 Plymouth City Dog Tags will be sold during the month of January at the Plymouth City Hall on **Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 9a.m. – 4p.m., Wednesday from 10a.m. – 5p.m., and Friday 9a.m. – 1p.m.**

Owners of dogs **four (4) months of age or older by January 1, 2014 MUST purchase a city dog tag.** A rabies vaccination certificate which **does not expire before June 30th, 2014** must be presented before a dog tag may be purchased.

Dogs under the age of four months **MUST** obtain a city dog tag within 30 days after becoming four months of age. Anyone obtaining a dog after January is also required to purchase a dog tag within 30 days.

The fee for dog tags purchased during the month of January is \$5.00 per tag. A \$2.00 per month delinquent penalty will be charged on all tags purchased **after** January 31st, 2014.

Anyone not able to purchase their dog tags at the above times is asked to call Alicia Fischer to make arrangements. Please **phone 696-3363** and leave your name and phone number and she will return your call.

Is your private well water safe?

In the state of Iowa, private wells are not regulated and it is up to the owner or user of the well to test for contaminants. If you are a private well owner or user, you may be eligible for FREE bacteria, nitrates and arsenic well water testing.
