2015 City Dog Tags

The 2015 Plymouth City Dog Tags will be sold during the month of January at the Plymouth City Hall on **Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 9a.m. – 4p.m., Wednesday from 10a.m. – 5p.m., and Friday 9a.m. – 1p.m.**

Owners of dogs **four (4) months of age or older by January 1, 2015 MUST purchase a city dog tag.** A rabies vaccination certificate which **does not expire before June 30th, 2015** must be presented before a dog tag may be purchased.

Dogs under the age of four months **MUST** obtain a city dog tag within 30 days after becoming four months of age. Anyone obtaining a dog after January is also required to purchase a dog tag within 30 days.

The fee for dog tags purchased during the month of January is \$5.00 per tag. A \$2.00 per month delinquent penalty will be charged on all tags purchased **after** January 31st, 2015.


