As a friendly reminder as we prepare for winter, no person shall park, abandon or leave unattended any vehicle on any public street, alley, or City-owned off-street parking area during snow removal operations unless the snow has been removed or plowed from said street, alley or parking area and the snow has ceased to fall. It is also unlawful for any person to throw, push, or place or cause to be thrown, pushed or placed, any ice or snow from private property, sidewalks, or driveways onto the traveled way of a street or alley so as to impede the passage of vehicles upon the street or alley or to create a hazardous condition therein.

From 1p.m. to 3p.m. every Monday afternoon, seniors are welcome to partake in a game of 500 at Plymouth City Hall. You are also welcome to return Tuesday mornings for coffee around 9 a.m. also at City Hall.
